


Adjusting the latch or positioning can help you and your baby breastfeed more comfortably.

## How can I get my baby to latch deeply?

Don't wait for baby to cry to let you know he is hungry (crying is a very late hunger cue), hold baby tummy to tummy and wait for baby to latch on by himself.

Often babies will latch deeply on their own.



This breastfeeding position is only one example, there are many others.
